Eligibility: IBSF license, max. 3 Monobob pilots per NF/gender, max. 4 Skeleton athletes

per NF/gender

Costs: <u>Accommodation:</u> on your own

Travel: on your own

Ice Time: out of the competition week on your own

Equipment/Entry

Monobob: € 500,-/week, if a NF has two or more athletes in a

different gender, every registered athlete will cost

€ 350,-/week; entry fee included

Skeleton: € 25,-/athlete entry fee, equipment on your own

Coaching: provided on application

General Information:

In case an athlete would be found to have committed an Anti Doping Rule Violation or in cases of serious misconduct, he will be immediately expelled from the program without notice and without any compensation and the IBSF must be reimbursed for.

For the purpose of this clause a serious misconduct is to be interpreted as any behavior that makes it immediately and permanently impossible for the parties to pursue their professional relationship. The following shall constitute examples of serious misconduct, which could give rise to the immediate termination: infringement of IBSF Statutes, infringement of the International Rules, Code of Ethics or Codes of Conduct, or any activity that harms or could harm IBSF reputation or image.

Registration:

The registration deadline for all training camps is October 1st. The number of participants is limited, first come first serve policy will be applied.

Registration is via the IBSF e-license and registration systems. For the qualification races entry closes 5 days before the first TCM. In case of non-participation without justification or timely cancellation (7 days before the start of the event), IBSF reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee of € 200,-/athlete.

Billing:

The fee for the sleds and the entry fee will be invoiced to the Federations via IBSF office.
